C. Commentary

The 4pm daily ministerial media briefing was led by the Transport Secretary, Grant Shapps. He announced a £2 billion package of measures 'to put cycling and walking at the heart of our transport policy'. He estimated that the UK public transport network would only have effective capacity for one in ten passengers on many parts of the network to allow for social distancing to be maintained once current lockdown measures are eased.

The Transport Secretary outlined elements of [statutory guidance](#) - effective immediately - requiring councils in England to create safer streets for pedestrians and cyclists. This will be followed by a national cycling plan in early June 2020 as part of the government's statutory Cycling and Walking Investment Strategy to help double cycling and increase walking by 2025.

At 7pm tonight, Sunday 10th May, the Prime Minister will reveal the government's roadmap and plans for moving to Phase 2 of the response to the pandemic.
