D. Commentary

The 4pm daily ministerial media briefing was led by the Communities Secretary, Robert Jenrick, who announced the next steps for those who are shielding. Mr Jenrick explained that at the start of the pandemic, the government advised that everyone who was clinically extremely vulnerable should shield until 30th June 2020. Individuals who fall within this category are those who are most at risk of severe illness if they contract COVID-19, so protecting them is vital.

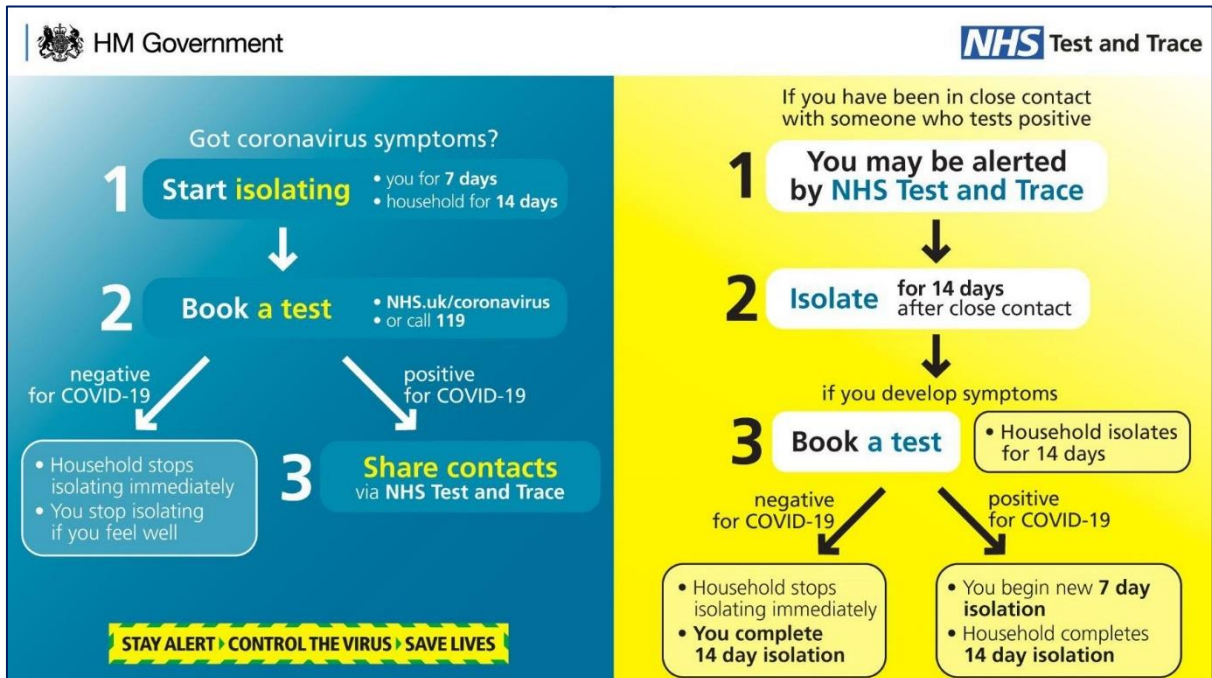


People who are clinically extremely vulnerable are not exclusively older people, and over half are under 70, with over 90,000 being children. Over 350,000 who are shielding have registered for some form of government support and, to date, over two and a half million free food boxes have been delivered. The National Shielding Service which was set up to support those needing help continues to provide much needed assistance in a variety of ways.

Mr Jenrick said the prevalence of COVID-19 in the community has reduced significantly and the risk to those shielding is now lower – as it is proportionately for the general population. This means that from Monday, 1st June 2020, people in England who are shielding will be allowed to spend some time outdoors. This may be with members of their own households or, if they live alone, with one person from another household. This relaxation reflects the fact that there is a lower risk of transmission outdoors, providing the two-metre social distancing rule is followed. Detailed revised [guidance](#) has been issued explaining about the new arrangements.

The government will next review the shielding measures during the week commencing Monday 15th June 2020.

Mr Jenrick provided an update on the measures taken to house rough sleepers during the pandemic, reporting that the vast majority of rough sleepers are now known, as well as where they are living. He announced that some 6,000 new supported homes will be provided, and previously announced government funding should ensure the accommodation is fast-tracked. This will hopefully prevent many rough sleepers from returning to the streets.
