D. Commentary

The 5pm ministerial media briefing was led by the Transport Secretary, Grant Shapps, who announced that the wearing of face coverings on all public transport in England will be mandatory from Monday 15th June 2020. This means that everyone travelling by bus, coach, train, tram, ferry and aircraft passengers must wear a face covering on their journey. There will be exemptions for very young children, the disabled and those with breathing difficulties.

The requirement is for face coverings and not surgical masks which must be kept for clinical settings. The government has previously issued guidance on [how to make and wear face coverings](#). The Transport Secretary pointed out that the scientific evidence suggests that face coverings offer some, albeit limited, protection against the spread of COVID-19.

Following the release on 2nd June 2020 of the Public Health England [review into disparities](#) in the risks and outcomes of COVID-19, the government's Equalities Hub will be responsible for taking forward work identified in the review. It will be led by the Equalities Minister, Kemi Badenoch.

The [Equalities Hub](#) sits in the Cabinet Office and is made up of officials working for the Government Equalities Office, Race Disparity Unit and Disability Unit.
