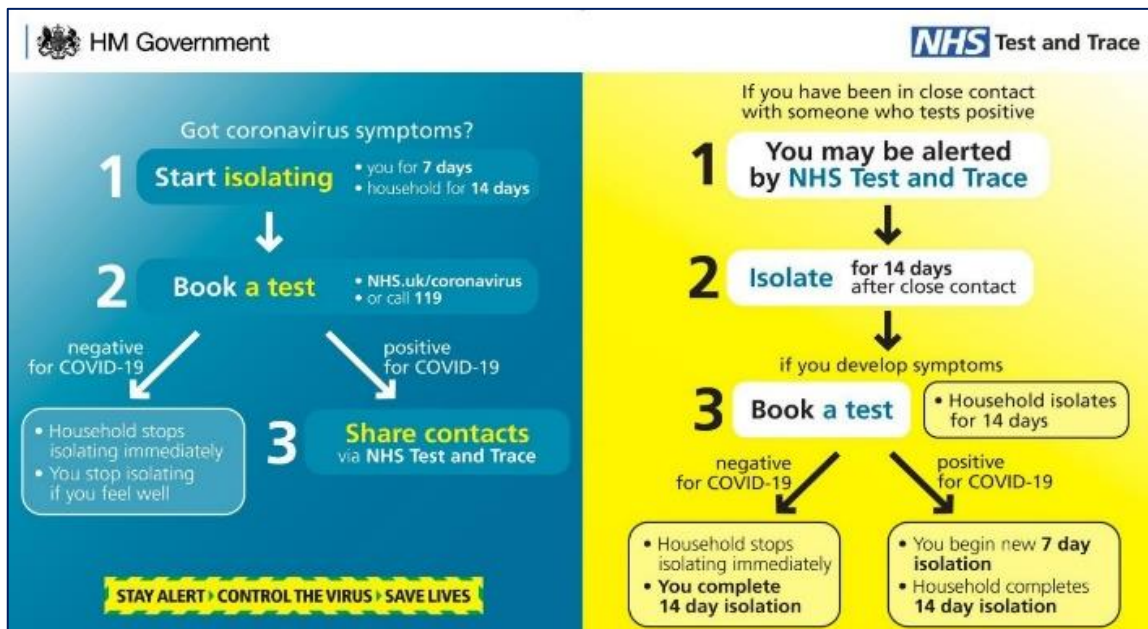
D. Commentary

The 5pm ministerial briefing was led by the Health and Social Care Secretary, Matt Hancock, who gave an update on the [NHS Test and Trace](#) service during week one of its operation. The new service helps trace close recent contacts of anyone who tests positive for COVID-19 and, if necessary, notifies them that they must self-isolate at home to help stop the spread of the virus.

The first weekly [NHS Test and Trace bulletin](#) for England for the period 28th May – 3rd June 2020 was published. Since the start of the service, 85% of those referred have been contacted and voluntarily self-isolated. Fifteen per cent have not yet been contacted although work to do this is continuing. Mr Hancock said he was pleased with the success achieved to date although did not rule out making the scheme compulsory if that became necessary. He pointed out that it is everyone's civic duty to self-isolate if contacted by the NHS Test and Trace service.

Guidance for the [safe use of places of worship](#) has been published. Places of worship will be permitted to open from Saturday 13th June 2020 for individual prayer.

The [Isle of Man government](#) has reported that there have been no new COVID-19 cases for the past 22 days and the legal requirement for social distancing within the community on the Island will be removed from Monday 15th June 2020, making it the first place in the British Isles to remove the restriction. Social distancing and the use of personal protective equipment will be maintained in the health and social care environment. Further announcements on gatherings in the Isle of Man will be made next week. The Isle of Man borders remain closed to non-residents (with some exemptions).
