D. Commentary

The number of deaths recorded in the UK where a positive COVID-19 test was carried out stands at 44,200.

The number of positive tests stands at 285,416. The methodology for reporting positive cases changed on 2 July 2020 to remove duplicates within and across pillars 1 and 2, to ensure that a person who tests positive is only counted once. Due to this change, 30,302 previously reported cases were removed from the UK total. Further information about the testing data is available [here](#).

The government's [Flexible Furlough Scheme](#) began on 1st July. Businesses now have the flexibility to bring furloughed employees back to work part time as part of the government's plan to re-open the UK and kick-start the economy.

Businesses will be given the flexibility to decide the hours and shift patterns of their employees – with the government continuing to pay 80% of salaries for the hours they do not work. The government reports that the Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme has so far helped protect more than 9.3 million jobs. The scheme will remain open until the end of October 2020.



Further easing of social distancing and lock-down restrictions continued with the opening of cafes, restaurants, bars and other venues in England on Saturday 4th July. Separate arrangements apply in Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland and these are explained on their respective websites at Section C on this briefing note.

There is an expectation that venues and businesses will [maintain records](#) of staff and visitors to support the NHS Track and Trace service and the following information should be collected by the venue, where possible:

Staff

- names of staff who work at the premises
- a contact phone number for each member of staff
- the dates and times that staff are at work

Customers and visitors

- the name of the customer or visitor. If there is more than one person, then the name of the 'lead member' of the group should be recorded together with the number of people in the group
- a contact phone number for each customer or visitor, or for the lead member of a group of people
- date of visit, arrival time and, where possible, departure time

If a customer interacts with only one member of staff (e.g., a hairdresser), the name of the assigned staff member should be recorded alongside the name of the customer.

The government has updated its global advisory against 'all but essential' travel, publishing a [list of countries](#) that no longer pose an unacceptably high risk for British travellers.

With effect from 10th July 2020, self-isolation for travellers returning to England will be lifted for lower risk countries, through travel corridor exemptions. Details of the countries are [here](#).
