D. Commentary

The UK economy was a key focus of discussion and debate during the week with the Chancellor of the Exchequer, Rishi Sunak, [announcing plans for creating new jobs](#) as part of his summer statement on Wednesday 8th July.

The government introduced the [Eat Out to Help Out Scheme](#) for restaurants and other eating establishments. Its purpose is to incentivise customers to eat out by giving them a discount which



restaurants can then claim back from the government. The scheme is UK-wide and customers will be able to see who is taking part on www.GOV.UK. The scheme's intention is to attract customers on quieter days of the week and hopefully help build businesses back up.

The key features of the scheme are to encourage diners to eat:

- all day, every Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday from 3rd to 31st August 2020
- to offer a 50% discount, up to a maximum of £10 per person, to diners for food or non-alcoholic drinks to eat or drink in
- restaurants will claim the money back from the government

There is no limit to the number of times customers can use the offer during the period of the scheme, which excludes alcohol and service charges. Registration for restaurants opens today, Monday 13th July, and closes on 31st August. Promotional materials are available [here](#).
