D. Commentary

Face coverings

Face coverings will be mandatory in all shops and supermarkets in England with effect from Friday 24th July 2020. This was announced to Parliament on 14th July by Matt Hancock, Secretary of State for Health and Social Care. Under the new rules, people who do not wear a face covering will face a fine of up to £100, in line with the arrangements on public transport. Children under 11 and those with certain disabilities will be exempt. The liability for wearing a face covering lies with the individual.

Should an individual without an exemption refuse to wear a face covering, a shop can refuse them entry and can call the police if people refuse to comply. The police have enforcement powers and can issue a fine.

Our plan to rebuild: the UK Government's COVID-19 recovery strategy [updated]

On Friday 17th July 2020, the government published its [updated roadmap](#) for how and when the UK will adjust its response to the COVID-19 crisis. This updates the document originally issued on 11 May. The purpose of that plan was to return to life as close to normal as possible, for as many people across the UK as possible, as fast and fairly as possible; in a way that avoids a new epidemic, minimises lives lost and maximises health, economic and social outcomes.
